### Sports Premium 2015 to 2016 Review

#### Grant Received – full academic year 2015-16 £9,165

**Objective** – This funding must be used to fund improvements to the provision of PE and sport, for the benefit of pupils aged 4-11 years old, in the 2015 to 2016 academic year, so that all pupils develop a healthy lifestyle.

**Objective for St Elizabeth's Primary School** – To continue to develop the positive impact of PE throughout the school, offering opportunities to all pupils.

To continue to develop Core PE in the curriculum</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To teach all classes once a week.</li> <li>• To co-ordinate the games afternoon on a Tuesday.</li> <li>• To assess schemes of work produced last year and update where necessary.</li> <li>• To support staff in their teaching of PE – through clear lesson plans, observation and one-to-one support.</li> </ul> <p><b>Impact</b> – ensure all children have the opportunity to participate in structured PE lessons, which show progression from lesson to lesson and year to year.</p> <p><b>Success</b> – All classes taught at least once a week by a Specialist Sports teacher.  <b>Guidance both in terms of lessons and equipment has been provided when lesson are taught by classroom teachers.</b>  <b>Schemes of work constantly updated. New schemes of work developed.</b>  <b>New areas introduced – Volleyball Year 5 and 6 - very popular.</b></p>

To continue to develop the inter- house competitions</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Increase the number of competitions for Year 4, 5 and 6 per year to include Rugby.</li> </ul> <p><b>Impact</b> - mass participation in competitive sport, alongside the experience of competing in a team.</p> <p><b>Success</b> – Inter house competitions included Football / Rugby / X Country / Volleyball / Athletics</p>

<p>3. To provide more sporting opportunities for our pupils.</p>	<p>Continued membership of the Richmond School Sport Partnership. The RSSP provides sporting opportunities for school children in the borough of Richmond Upon Thames. The RSSP provides coaching and leadership opportunities, festivals and competitions. The service also offers good quality CPD, monitors the competency of outside providers and acts as a PE advisory service.</p> <p>To increase the number of friendly fixtures for Year 5 and 6.</p> <p>Increase fixtures for Year 3 and 4. Encourage parents to help manage the teams.</p> <p><b>Impact</b> – Increases the opportunities for pupils and improves links with Borough Primary Schools</p> <p><b>Success – Entered all Borough Tournaments and leagues. Local cluster competitions included Year 3 and 4 football / Multi skills for Year 2 and 5. Year 2 reaching the finals.</b></p> <p><b>Year 3 and 4 Tag Rugby Tournament.</b></p> <p><b>Netball team reaching the league final.</b></p> <p><b>Friendly games introduced in Football / Rugby and Netball</b></p>
<p>5. To oversee Specialist Sports Coaches.</p>	<p>Sport coaches work alongside staff and pupils in lessons and clubs.</p> <p>To increase the number of outside coaches supporting extra-curricular activities.</p> <p>Investigate the possibility of introducing a gymnastics coach.</p> <p><b>Impact</b> - To increase the quality of PE delivered, and to enable a wider breath of extra curricular activities.</p> <p><b>Success – The introduction of Year 1 and 2 football club.</b></p> <p><b>Introduced a Gymnastics club with an external coach from April 2016. Combining Infants and Juniors.</b></p>

To set up and run a Sports Committee</p>	<p>Year 6 pupils to write a letter of application and go through an interview process to join a Sports Committee.</p> <p><b>Impact</b> – Sports Committee to support the PE Co-ordinator in the development of PE throughout the school. To enable them to take ownership of sporting events.</p> <p><b>Success</b> – <b>Sports Committee formed in January 2016 – supporting the PE department in all interhouse activities / organising Sports Leaders / tidying store cupboard. Being good role models to the younger children.</b></p>
<p>7. To carry out an audit of existing equipment and purchases additional resources.</p>	<p>New PE resources to be ordered to meet the needs of the broader PE curriculum planned.</p> <p><b>Impact</b> – Improve quality of teaching and enjoyment for all pupils. Allow for a broader curriculum, meeting the needs of a wider number of pupils.</p> <p><b>Success</b> – <b>Purchasing of Volleyballs / Athletic equipment / New Tennis rackets.</b></p>
