Ludwig van Beethoven
Arr. Mizue Marakami

1770 Born in Bonn, Germany

1787 Traveled to Vienna to study with Mozart

1792 Traveled again to Vienna to study with Haydn

1800 Wrote Symphony No. 1 in C major, Opus 21

1802 Depression & deafness affects his life

1803-1814 Wrote 2nd through 8th Symphonies

1817-1824 Wrote four piano sonatas & his 9th Symphony

1827 Beethoven's death
