

Key words

Strings	Instruments that make sound by plucking/bowing strings.
Woodwind	Instruments that were originally made out of wood.
Brass	Instruments that are made out of brass (not the saxophone)
Percussion	Instruments that make sound by being hit, scraped or shaken.
Conductor	The leader of the orchestra who keeps everyone in time
