

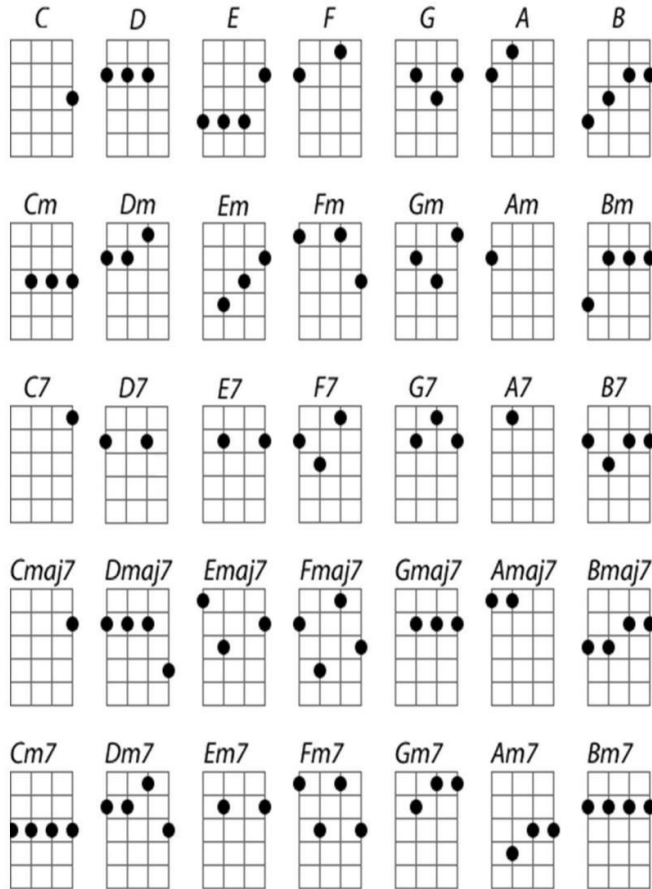

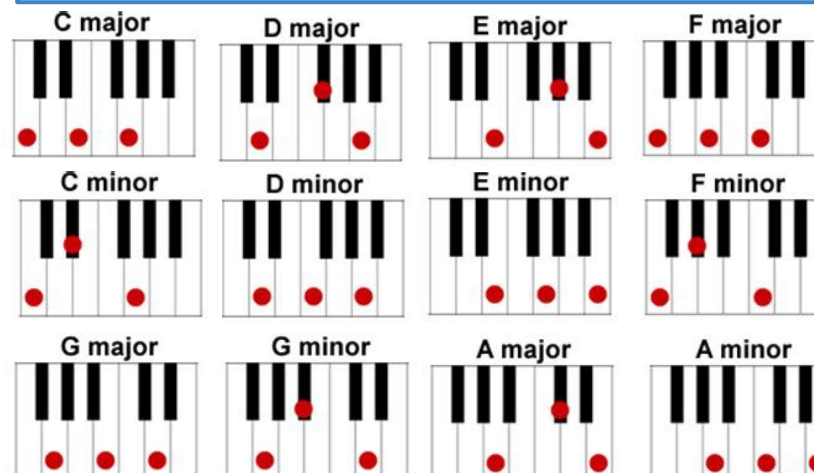

### Key words

<b>DRSMITH</b>	An acronym that represents the different musical elements: Dynamics, Rhythm/Metre/Tempo, Structure, Melody, Instrumentation, Texture, Harmony and Tonality
<b>Chord Sequence</b>	A series of chords that are repeated during a song
<b>Passing notes</b>	Melody notes that don't belong to the chord they are played against
<b>Syncopation</b>	Offbeat
<b>Hook</b>	Catchy memorable part of a song
