Key words

Loop	There are two meanings. A loop (noun) is a pre-recorded bit of music part of the 'loops library' on BandLab, but you can also loop a track so that it repeats over and over.
Panning	How the sound is distributed over a speaker set or headphones (is one instrument coming out of the left headphone and the other out of the right?)
Layers	How many different loops are playing at one time.
Bass Drop	Where sounds build up and suddenly all drop out - apart from the bass.
Fade out	When the sound gradually gets quieter and quieter until silent
Automation	The button used to adjust the volume of an existing track as it is playing.
