Prior Learning

Children will have experience of being part of a family.

Knowledge/Scripture/Liturgy

In this topic children will explore who they are to appreciate their value and uniqueness. Children will explore that God creates each person in love, in his own image and likeness.

Prayer

- ❑ Morning and night prayer
- ❑ Prayer of thanksgiving for making me 'me'.
- ❑ Grace before and after meals

Big Question

Why am I precious and how do I know God loves me?

To answer this question the children will use the knowledge learned within RE lessons and make links to the scripture that was used.

- ❑ Children will be able to **talk about** their own feelings, experiences of being known and called by their name
- ❑ Children will **talk about, explore and recognise** of the importance of first and family names.
- ❑ Through Isaiah 43:1-2, the children will **talk about, explore and recognise** that God knows everyone by name.
- ❑ Through Psalm 131, children **will talk about, explore and recognise** will that God loves each person.
- ❑ Children will **recognise** that everyone is precious to God.
- ❑ Children will **recognise** that prayer is talking and listening to God and It is possible to pray at any time.
- ❑ Children will **celebrate** their new knowledge and understanding by planning, leading and delivering their own end of topic liturgy.

- ❑ **Family name:** surname, name that comes last.
- ❑ **Class name:** Name of your class-Reception
- ❑ **Precious:** something greatly loved or valued.
- ❑ **Parent:** a mother or father of a child.
- ❑ **God:** the creator of the world and people.
- ❑ **Love:** strong and warm affection.
- ❑ **Prayer:** words spoken to God.
