Palm Sunday.



Palm Sunday marks the first day of Holy Week

Holy Thursday- The Last Supper

We heard that Jesus shared bread and wine and said they were his body and blood.

Deacon Quentin explained the meaning and significance of the Eucharist.

The link was made that we remember The Last Supper every time we go to Mass.

The Gospel message of giving thanks and remembering to thank Jesus for His love and sacrifice every time we go to Mass was shared.
