### Link to end of year descriptors

#### Learning from Religion

- Make links to show how feelings and beliefs affect their commitment to community and that of others.
- Making links to Scripture to support a point of view

### Key words

**Community:** A group of people living in the same place or having an area of interest in common

**Commitment:** A promise to do something

**Responsibility:** Doing the things you are expected to do and accepting the consequences of your actions

**Parish:** A church district under the care of a priest

**Laity:** The people of a religion who are not priests

**Ministries:** The duties of a religious minister

**Extraordinary Ministers:** Distribute Holy Communion when an ordinary minister is not able to

**Pastoral areas:** A group of neighbouring parishes which support one another

**Service:** Performing one's religious duty towards God

**Funeral rites:** The ceremony to a dead person before burial

**Deanery:** The office or residence of a dean

### Knowledge/Scripture/Liturgy

In the local church, lay people of all ages are called to undertake various roles, called ministries, by virtues of their Baptism and Confirmation. They help to build up the local community of the parish.

- Children will **explore and identify** the different communities they belong to and share experiences of the responsibility and commitment of belonging to a community.
- Through scripture (Mark 3:13-19) children will **retell and make links** between the call of the apostles and God's call to people to serve Him today.
- Children will **explore and learn** what community means, and the features of a parish community and pastoral area.
- Children will **explore, identify and explain** some of the roles and ministries within the parish community and give reasons why people serve.
- Children will **understand and describe** some of the advice and messages within the Scripture used about serving the community (Acts 6:2-13, 7:57-60) and how the parish community celebrates together and supports one another (St Paul letter to the Romans 12:8-11).
- Children will **describe and give reasons for** the actions and symbols within a funeral Mass.
- Children will **celebrate** their new knowledge and understanding by planning, leading and delivering their own end of topic liturgy.
