In addition, as part of our Advent preparation, Pupil Chaplains launched 'One Kind Act' in assembly.

Children were encouraged to undertake one kind act each day at home.

This was annotated on their Advent Calendar.

Children were rewarded financially for carrying out kind acts and the money earned went to benefit the CAFOD charity.

Each class pooled the money they have collected together to buy World Gifts.

The children in each class decided what gifts to buy with the money raised.

Each class was able to buy a number of gifts.
