Vocabulary:

Family: A group of people based on love

Meal: To sit down and eat food together

Mass: Act of worship where Christians gather to give thanks to God.

Blessing: A special prayer

Altar: The table where the religious event happens

Last Supper: The final meal that Jesus shared with his Apostles before his crucifixion

Holy Communion: When the bread and wine turn into the body and blood of Jesus at Mass

Knowledge/Scripture/Liturgy

The parish family gathers for the Eucharist (Mass), Jesus' special meal. We find strength in gathering for the celebration of the Eucharist and of God's love in our lives.

- ☐ Children will **talk about** their experience and feelings about meals which are special to them.
- ☐ Children will **ask and respond** to questions about meals which are special to them.
- Children will recognise the story of Jesus' special meal at the Last Supper through scripture (Luke 22:19-20).
- ☐ Children will **retell** the story of Jesus' special meal, The Last Supper, and make links between The Last Supper and Mass.
- ☐ Children will **name and talk about** what happens during some of the parts of the Mass the Preparation of the Gifts and Holy Communion.
- ☐ Children will be able to **use religious words** to say what happens at Holy Communion during Mass.
- ☐ Children will recognise and begin to understand the presence of Jesus in Holy Communion
- ☐ Children will **learn** the prayer, Our Father.
- ☐ Children will **celebrate** their new knowledge and understanding by planning, leading and delivering their own end of topic liturgy.
