Knowledge/Scripture/Liturgy

Christians believe that life is God's gift. Appreciating that all is a gift leads us to treasure everything in life.

- Children will **ask and respond** to questions about their own and others' experiences of and feelings about what we treasure.
- Children will **make links** between how they feel about their treasure and how that might affect their behaviour and that of others.
- Through Scripture (Creation story in Genesis and Psalm 19 and 147) children will **retell** some special stories about creation and the treasures of God's world and be able to **describe** some ways in which religion is lived out by believers in the way they treasure God's world.
- Children will **give reasons** for actions by believers in relation to treasuring God's world with a particular focus on CAFOD's work on the precious treasure of water.
- Through praying the Gloria, children will **praise** God for the treasures in His world.
- Through the example of CAFOD, children will **explore, identify** and put into practice ways we can help to make a fairer world with a particular focus on water usage
- Children will **celebrate** their new knowledge and understanding by planning, leading and delivering their own end of topic liturgy.
