Prior knowledge

Key words

Change: Make something different

Seasons: Four divisions in the school year

Spring growth: New life that appears during Spring

Lent: The time of year where Christians prepare for Easter; Lent lasts 40 days

Ash Wednesday: The first day of Lent

Good Friday: The day Christians remember when Jesus died on the cross

Easter Sunday: The day Christians celebrate the resurrection of Jesus from the dead

Alleluia: Praise God

Cross: The structure on which Jesus was crucified

Resurrection: The act of coming back from the dead

Knowledge/Scripture/Liturgy

Lent offers a time to reflect on life and change. This is a time to prepare for Easter. Change is a necessary part of healthy growth.

- Children will **talk** about their experiences and feelings about changing and acquiring new skills.
- Children will **ask** wondering questions about the ways in which change happens.
- Children will **explore and describe** how we can change and make a new start during Lent.
- Children will **recognise** what happens on Ash Wednesday and **recognise** the ash as a symbol.
- Children will **recognise** and **retell** the story of Palm Sunday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday.
- Children will **recognise** some religious words and symbols and **describe** some actions from Ash Wednesday, Palm Sunday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday
- Children will **recognise and describe** how Christians use Lent as a time for change
- Children will **recognise** that Easter Sunday is the day when we celebrate that Jesus is alive.
- Children will **celebrate** their new knowledge and understanding by planning, leading and delivering their own end of topic liturgy.
