### **Prior knowledge**

## **Big Question**

To answer this question the children will use the knowledge learned within RE lessons and make links to the scripture that was used.

- Describe some of the actions and choices of believers that arise because of their faith.

#### **Learning from Religion**

Ask and respond to questions about their own and others' feelings, experiences and things about how people give themselves to others.

Resurrection: Jesus' rising from the dead

**Sorrowful Mysteries:** Part of the Rosary that highlights the events in Jesus' life from Holy

Thursday to Good Friday.

### Knowledge/Scripture/Liturgy

Lent and Holy Week are times of giving in different ways and remembering the total giving of Jesus.

- Children will be able to ask and respond to questions of their own and others' experience and feelings of how people give themselves for others.
- ☐ Children will begin to **make links** to show how feelings and beliefs affect their own and others' attitude to giving of themselves.
- ☐ Using the Gospel accounts, children will be able to **retell** some of the stories of Holy Week and the Resurrection: The Agony in the Garden, Good Friday and The Resurrection.
- ☐ Children will be able to use religious words and phrases to **describe** the religious actions and symbols of Lent and Holy Week.
- ☐ Children will be able to **describe and give**reasons for some ways in which Christians
  use the time of Lent to give to others.
- Through The Beatitudes, children will begin to make links between the scripture and what Christians believe about how they should act.
- ☐ Children will **celebrate** their new knowledge and understanding by planning, leading and delivering their own end of topic liturgy.
