Prior knowledge

The children have learned previously celebrating growth to new life.

Big Question

What does sacrifice mean in daily life?

To answer this question the children will use the knowledge learned within RE lessons and make links to the scripture that was used.

Link to end of year descriptors

Learning from Religion

- Show knowledge and understanding of a range of scripture passages that corresponds to the scripture source
- Show an understanding of how actions of believers arise as a consequence of their beliefs (various liturgies).

Key words

Giving: Caring
Carer: Someone who helps another person
Cost: Consequence
Temptation: Considering doing something wrong or unwise
Betrayal: To be unfaithful to a friend
Self-sacrifice: To give up your own needs for someone else's
Holy Week: The last week of the 40 days of Lent
Maundy Thursday: When we remember the Last Supper
Gethsemane: The place where Jesus and his disciples prayed before his crucifixion
Altar of repose: Altar on which sacraments are preserved from Maundy Thurs to Good Fri
Love: A feeling of affection
Crucifixion: Killing by nailing hands + feet to cross
Easter vigil: Church celebration of Resurrection of Christ
Resurrection: To come back from the dead

Knowledge/Scripture/Liturgy

Lent is the season when Christians try to focus on giving. This helps us to identify with the complete sacrifice of Jesus which is remembered in the liturgy of Holy Week, especially the Easter Triduum (Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday - Easter Sunday).

- Children will **make links** to show how feeling and beliefs affect giving and refusing to give and appreciating the cost of giving
- Children will **make links** between the scripture stories of Holy Week and the Temptation in the desert and how Christians observe the season of Lent.
- Through Gospel accounts children will **describe, understand and make links between** Jesus' sacrifice and His resurrection.
- Children will use a developing religious vocabulary to **give reasons** for religious actions and symbols used during Holy Week and the Easter Vigil.
- Children will be able to **give reasons** why Christians make sacrifices during Lent.
- Children will begin to use religious terms to **show an understanding** of the different liturgies of Holy Week and the Easter Vigil.
- Children will begin to **show understanding** of how belief in the sacrifice Jesus made, and belief in the Resurrection shapes lives.
- Children will begin to **engage with and respond** to questions about sacrifice in the light of religious teaching.
- Children will **celebrate** their new knowledge and understanding by planning, leading and delivering their own end of topic liturgy.
