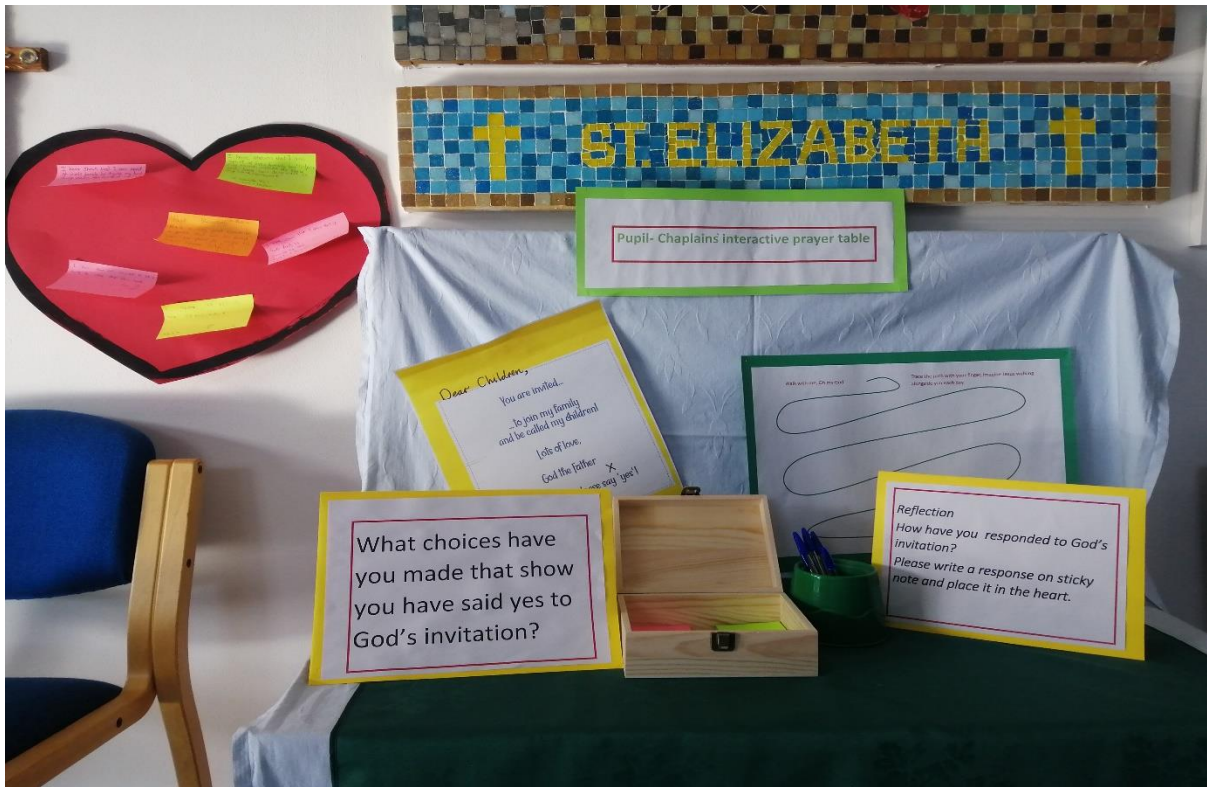

Pupil Chaplains interactive prayer area

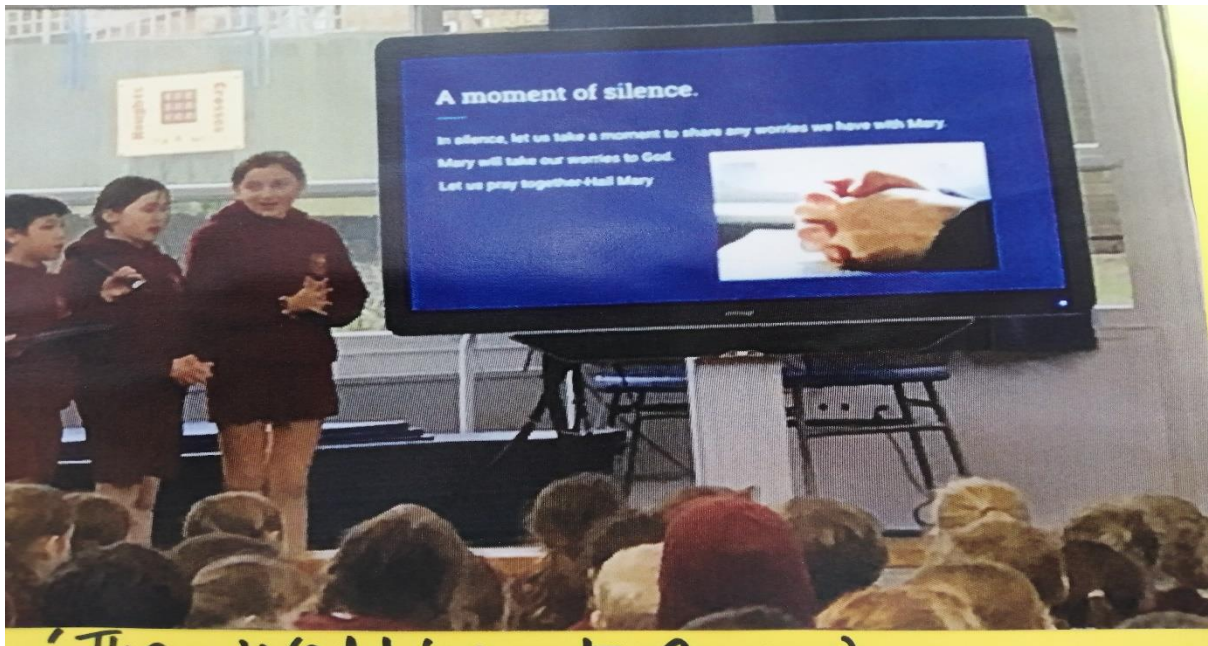
As a follow-up from the Gospel assemblies during January, the Pupil Chaplains have created an interactive prayer table in the hall where the children are asked to respond to God's invitation to say yes to be part of His family.

Through this display the children are encouraged to record on sticky notes how they had said yes to Jesus' invitation.

The annotated sticky notes are placed within a heart.

Pupil Chaplains led a Gospel assembly independently.

Pupil Chaplains dramatized Jesus' first public miracle- The Wedding at Cana.

When the wine ran out, Mary's response of help helped others to believe in Jesus.

Mary said to the servants, 'Do whatever He tells you.' (John 2: 1 – 11)

The children in assembly watched as the Pupil Chaplains turned the water into wine. The impact of what the children saw further reinforced the message that Jesus is the Son Of God. Then, the Pupil Chaplains invited children to take any worries they have straight to Jesus by praying and talking to Him.

The children in assembly were asked to reflect on how they could become more like Jesus in their daily life by listening to Him, following Him and believing in Him.
