Safeguarding update

In yesterday's assembly Miss Thomas, who is our Designated Safeguarding Lead, introduced herself to the children and explained her role in keeping children safe in school, at home and online. Miss Thomas shared our child friendly safeguarding policy which is displayed in poster form in each classroom. A copy of the poster has been attached to this mail for your information. We consistently give the message to our children that if they are worried or feel unsafe they can talk to any trusted adult who will listen and take action. In school this means all adults wearing staff lanyards.

Punctuality

Thank you for ensuring that your child is in school before 9:00am. Our school doors open at 8:50am and the learning starts as soon as the children enter their classroom. Please ensure you give your child the best start to their school day by arriving on time.

School site during clubs

We have been reviewing the security of our school site after school and during school clubs. At 3:25pm we shut our school gates to keep the site secure for school clubs and NSSport. The gates are opened at 4:10pm for clubs pick up and are shut once again at 4:25pm. Parents, carers and siblings are not able to stay on site during clubs and we ask that parents leave promptly after club pick up. Children are also not permitted to play on play equipment or with playground toys after school. These measures will ensure that the security of the school during and after clubs is as strict as during normal school hours. Thank you for your co-operation in this.
